Title: Max and the Grasshopper

Language Objective: The student will learn to use plural nouns

Instructions: Use this card with the books "Max and the Grasshopper". Take as long as the student needs to learn the skills. You may need to model the language multiple times for them to learn it. By modeling the language, you are motivating the student to learn. You may need to add the student's favorite drinks to their talker if they aren't already there. This will ensure that the activity is relevant.

Steps:

- 1. Read the book, "Max and the Grasshopper," together. Stop when you come to a plural noun and let the student say the word with their device. The same can be done with books you might have at home.
- 2. When preparing for dinner, set the table with the student. Hold up an item that needs to go on the table like a plate. Have the student say the plural form: plates. Continue with more items: cup, knife, fork, spoon.
- 3. Look through photographs or magazines and try to find instances of plural nouns. Create a story about the plural nouns you find.
