Instructions

- Print out all cards and place them face down in front of the student. Have them turn over a card and use their device to name its opposite. They can then turn over another card and see if it is the correct match. If it is not a match, turn over both cards and try again.
- One variation is to require the person to use the word in a sentence instead of just naming it's opposite.
- Use the same cards and play "Go Fish". Deal out all the cards and have the person use their device to ask for an opposite of a card in their hand.
- Have them use phrases such as "Do you have _____?" or "Can I have _____?". When you find a set of opposites, you get a point. Play until all the sets are made.
